Supporting Missouri's PREGNANT FOSTER YOUTH

The Children's Trust Fund is partnering with Home State Health's Show Me Healthy Kids to connect pregnant foster youth to home visiting services.

What is Show Me Healthy Kids?

Show Me Healthy Kids is a health plan that coordinates health care services for children and youth in foster care, extended foster care, adoption support, and young adult alumni of the foster care program.

Connecting pregnant foster youth to home visiting services through their Show Me Healthy Kids health plan will improve outcomes in health, safety, education, and economic mobility for Missouri's most vulnerable mothers and babies.

How does the Coordinated Referral & Intake System work?



Show Me Healthy Kids staff will contact the foster youth to inform them of prenatal services available through their health plan.



Staff will offer to make a home visiting referral with the youth's informed consent.



With consent, staff will make a home visiting referral through the Coordinated Referral & Intake System (CRIS) to connect with a local home visiting provider.

How do I make referrals for pregnant foster youth?

Referrals will be steered toward intensive or evidence-based home visiting that meets the unique needs and circumstances of pregnant foster youth.
