



What is the Missouri Home Visiting Referral System?

This system is an online platform that makes it easy to refer a family to early childhood home visiting services (prenatal to five) anywhere in the state through one of five regional referral networks.

Each regional referral network, or CRIS, is managed by a state-funded home visiting collective impact site and includes a variety of early childhood home visiting programs and models.

How does it work?

Anyone can make a referral by submitting an online form through their regional CRIS network (see above). Once the referral is submitted, the regional CRIS assigns the family to a home visiting program based on the family's needs and eligibility, and the program's capacity.

The assigned home visiting agency then contacts the family to tell them more about their program and offer services.

What are the benefits?

- It's FREE & EASY to use
- Easy to turn off referrals to manage capacity
- Matches families with programs that best meet their needs
- CRIS can be supplemental to your other referral sources
- No need to remember:
 - Coverage areas
 - Eligibility criteria
 - Capacity to serve
