

Home Visiting Transition FAQ: MIECHV & MOPPP

As part of the transition of MIECHV and MOPPP funding to the Children's Trust Fund (CTF), we have compiled answers to some frequently asked questions to support contractors through this change. You can also find who to reach out to for any additional questions below.

How will invoicing work for contractors transitioning to CTF?

Starting July 1, invoicing for both MIECHV and MOPPP contractors will be **due on the 15th of each month**. The first invoice due to CTF will be **August 15th for July expenses.** Detailed instructions regarding where and how to submit your invoices will be provided by CTF.

Will contractors need to use a new budget template?

Yes, CTF will share a budget template with all contractors. However, the new template will closely resemble the one previously used under DESE/OOC to ensure a smooth transition.

What should contractors expect for annual onsite visits?

Due to the transition from DESE/OOC to CTF, there will not be an annual onsite visit this summer. However, CTF is committed to conducting in-person site visits within the next year to meet with each contractor directly.

Will monthly monitoring meetings continue?

Yes! CTF will continue hosting regular monthly monitoring meetings. You can expect new calendar invites from Laura Malzner, and CTF will aim to maintain the same meeting schedule used by DESE/OOC.

Do contractors need to update program marketing materials to reflect CTF as the new funder?

What funding streams support home visiting activities through CTF?

CTF is supported by a combination of funding sources, including:

- Missouri General Revenue
- Children's Trust Fund (CTF)
- Community-Based Child Abuse Prevention (CBCAP) (federal)
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) 9federal)
- Maternal Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV) (federal)
- Additionally, CTF is working to create a funding stream to support billing for home visiting services for a subset of highrisk perinatal members. Will anything change with regard to REDCap data entry?
