## How do I get my CTF license plates?

**The easiest way to get your CTF license plates is** to make your CTF donation (\$25 or more for one year or \$50 or more for two years) when you get your license plates **in-person at any DOR license office.**

You can also make your donation separately and present it at any DOR license office. Donations can be made by:

- check or money order to Children's Trust Fund, **P.O. Box 1641, Jefferson City, MO 65102-1641**

## Upon receipt of your donation, CTF will send you:

- your *Logo Use Authorization Statement* (donation receipt)
- an application for personalized license plates (DOR 1716) for any new plate request

## Next...

**Submit all required paperwork** (DOR 1716 application, *Logo Use Authorization Statement*, annual DOR \$15 plate fee) to your local DOR license office or mail it to the Motor Vehicle Bureau, PO Box 100, Jefferson City, MO 65105-0100 (573-526-3669).

## Finally...

**DOR will mail your plates to you or notify you by mail** when they are available for pickup at your local license office.

**Contact your local DOR office for more information.**

## Just so you know:

- CTF plates may be ordered any time of year regardless of the license plate expiration date. However, ALL CTF plates will be assigned a July renewal date, and the Missouri Department of Revenue (DOR) will pro-rate any fees accordingly.
- If you currently have personalized plates, your 'message' can be transferred to the CTF plates.
- Character limits for personalized plates are **6 characters** for regular plates, **5 characters** for motorcycle plates and **4 characters** for disability plates.
- DOR will assess an annual \$15 fee (\$30 for two year plates).
